QATAR AIRWAYS

Move between Milan's urban energy and Switzerland's Alpine landscapes over ten well-paced days. Begin with Lake Como, the Duomo and Serravalle's designer outlets before crossing into Switzerland for Zermatt, Grindelwald, Interlaken, Lucerne, Bern and Zurich. Stand beneath the Matterhorn in car-free Zermatt, ride the cogwheel train to Jungfrauoch at 3,454 metres, and visit Rhine Falls and Lucerne's Chapel Bridge between mountain journeys. The route balances landmark cities with unhurried scenery, making it ideal for travellers who want both without cutting either short. Return Qatar Airways flights via Doha, checked baggage, halal meals, guided touring and tipping are included.

Departure from KLIA

Depart KLIA, transit through Doha

Check in at KLIA three to four hours ahead of the Qatar Airways departure. The flight routes through Doha for a connection only — no stopover — continuing on to Milan Malpensa, where you land the next morning local time.

MILAN • OVERNIGHT 1 OF 2

Milan

Arrive via Lake Como and Como town

Your guide meets you on arrival at Milan Malpensa and the group heads straight for Lake Como, an hour out. Wander the lakefront promenade, or take the optional cruise across to Bellagio, the village where the lake's two southern arms meet and one of its most photographed viewpoints.

The afternoon is yours to spend independently — Como's historic centre and cathedral square are an easy walk from the promenade, or simply take a coffee with the mountains reflected across the water.

Milan

Duomo, La Scala and Serravalle Outlet

The morning covers Milan's historic core on foot — past La Scala and Castello Sforzesco to the Duomo, whose roofline of 3,400 statues is worth circling twice — before the coach heads out to Serravalle, one of northern Italy's largest outlet malls, where over 120 designer brands make for a different kind of shopping stop.

Milan — Zermatt

Into the Alps via Tasch

The coach departs Milan mid-morning and crosses into Switzerland en route to Tasch. Since Zermatt is car-free, a shuttle train carries you the final five kilometres up into the village, arriving by early afternoon — the Matterhorn visible from most points the moment you step off. The rest of the day is free: wander Bahnhofstrasse's watch shops and outfitters, or just find a view of the peak.

GRINDELWALD • OVERNIGHT 1 OF 2

Tasch — Grindelwald

Montreux, Lake Blausee and Iseltwald

The coach leaves Tasch in the morning for a long driving day toward Grindelwald, with three stops to break up the distance. First the Château de Chillon on Lake Geneva's shore, a 13th-century island fortress reached by a narrow wooden bridge; then into the Bernese Highlands to Lake Blausee, whose water is startlingly clear even by Swiss standards and doubles as a filming location for *Crash Landing on You*; and a brief stop in Iseltwald, the lakeside village from the same series, before arriving into Grindelwald in the evening.

Grindelwald

Lauterbrunnen and Jungfrauoch

The morning starts with a stop in Lauterbrunnen, at the base of a sheer-walled valley with 72 waterfalls — the Staubbach is visible from the valley floor. From there, the cogwheel train bores through the Eiger up to Jungfrauoch at 3,454 metres, the highest railway station in Europe, with views across the Aletsch Glacier. The coach returns to Grindelwald by evening for a second night in the same hotel.

Grindelwald — Zurich

Bern and Rhine Falls

The coach leaves Grindelwald in the morning for Bern — compact enough to properly walk, six kilometres of arcaded streets under a 16th-century clock tower whose animated figures perform on the hour. From there it continues to Schaffhausen for Rhine Falls, Europe's most powerful waterfall by volume, where a viewing platform on the north bank puts you close enough to feel the spray, before the coach carries on to Zurich for the night.

Zurich

Mount Titlis and Lucerne

Mount Titlis takes most of the morning: a sequence of gondola lifts from Engelberg up to 3,020 metres, the last of them the Rotair, the world's first rotating cable car, ending on a glacier terrace with a suspension bridge and snow year-round (optional excursion, 90 CHF). Afterward, the pace drops in Lucerne, where the wooden Chapel Bridge — built in 1333 and the oldest covered bridge in Europe — is the reason to slow down, before the coach returns to Zurich in the evening.

Zurich

Old town, Bahnhofstrasse, then depart

The morning is unhurried by design: Zurich's old town straddles both banks of the Limmat, with guild houses, narrow alleys, and a clock face on St Peter's Church that's the largest in Europe. Walk down Bahnhofstrasse, one of the most expensive shopping streets in the world, before the afternoon transfer to Zurich Airport for the Qatar Airways flight home via Doha.
